## Mission: St. Louis Affordable Christmas event helps over 500 families

St. Louis, MO. - Each year, Mission: St. Louis hosts an empowering holiday event that allows people to provide Christmas for their families. The Mission: St. Louis office on North Grand was transformed into a toy store for families to shop for gifts at a discounted rate.

Shoppers could spend \$4 for each child they registered, up to six children. Toys were priced at drastically reduced prices ranging from \$1-\$4 based off the market value of the toy. Families also received winter wear, gingerbread houses, breakfast kits for Christmas morning and had the choice to get their gifts wrapped.

The event was held on December 9th from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. with the help of Mission: St. Louis staff and 200 community volunteers. This year 1,826 children from 507 families received gifts through the event.

Over 4,500 toys were available for families to choose from, including 200 bikes, drones, baby dolls and more. All toys were new and were donated through 46 toy drives around the city, hundreds of individuals or bought by Mission: St. Louis.
