# Affordable Christmas



## AN EMPOWERING HOLIDAY EVENT:

Completely online, people who did not have access to the internet could come to the office and shop via iPad

- Over 5,500 toys stocked our virtual store
- 671 families had a brighter Christmas
- 1,540 children received Christmas gifts
- All who registered were invited to shop
- 32 toy drives
- 300 backpacks
- 100 pairs of shoes

# 2020 Wrap Up

# Beyond School 2020

## In 2020:

- 2 city schools
- 178 students enrolled
- 91% of students improved in their reading and math skills
- Reading skills were increased by 2.6 years
- Math skills were increased by 2.2 years
- Success Coaches conducted over 10,000 zoom meetings with their students
- 85% of families attended virtual Family Nights



# Beyond Jobs & EACH1 2020



## In 2020:

- 52 members were directly hired by partner employers
- 8 members were placed in transitional jobs
- 8 people placed through Hire St. Louis
- \$13 average starting wage
- Our EACH1 community hub expanded with several new partners
- 254 cases were worked on by SLU legal clinic
- 1 family was helped into housing through HomeFirst
- Provided over \$320,000 in rental and mortgage assistance

# Beyond Charity

## 2020



### In 2020:

- 9 essentials drives served on average 43 different zip codes
- 150 seniors were delivered essential supplies
- More than 80 lawns were mowed
- 620 repairs were completed in over 56 homes
- 150 large-scale projects were completed through Healthy Home Repair
